Warehouse Delivery Driver

Job Description:

Seafoods of the World was founded in 1978 under the motto: "Seafood is Our Business. Top Quality at the Right Price." 15 years ago we added fresh seafood to our repertoire, providing Montana and Wyoming restaurants, grocery stores and distributors with quality fresh products. Today we continue to offer quality fresh and frozen products at affordable prices.

The warehouse delivery driver will be responsible for setting up customer orders and delivering to Billings and Bozeman restaurants. This position will independently drive our truck to and from Bozeman on Tuesday and Fridays. During other days of the week, this position will be responsible for setting up and completing a portion of local deliveries.

This position will work closely with our Warehouse Manager and Seafood Handling Assistant.

Hours:

This position is for a full-time employment of approximately 39 hours a week, with 1-2 less hours per week during the off season (January-April). Our ideal schedule is listed below plus ½ hour lunches on Mondays and Thursdays. End times will vary based on delivery route completion. Because of increased sales around holidays, no employees are allowed time off during the last three weeks of December and around some major holidays.

Thursday	8 am – 2:30 pm
Friday	5 am – 6 pm

Pay:

Hourly pay of \$16.00. Anticipated raises to \$16.50 after six months and \$17.00 after one year of employment. No health benefits offered at this time. Simple IRA during third year over \$5000 in wages.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities:

- Use customer invoices to pick and organize orders for delivery routes, which will require spending extended amounts of time in the freezer.
- Use company cargo van to deliver to Billings restaurants 2 times per week.
- Use company box truck to deliver to Bozeman restaurants 2 times per week.
- Operate Forklift and Pallet Jack on a weekly basis. Prior experience is preferred, but not required.
- Prepare pallets for out-of-town deliveries, including organizing, stacking and wrapping customer orders.
- Complete truck maintenance log each week.
- Perform other duties as assigned or needed.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Valid Driver's License with clean driving record. Company vehicle will be provided for deliveries.
- Reach, lift and maneuver objects of varying dimensions and weights up to 100 pounds, frequently.
- Handle refrigerated and frozen food products and enter frozen and cold storage areas for extended periods of time.
- Willingness to work and communicate effectively as a team.
- Ability to stand on feet for extended periods of time.
- Ability to drive for extended periods of time.
